



This is how you enter on-line

It takes only a few easy steps to complete your on-line entry to the ADAC GT Masters series and transmit the data.

Step 1 Registration:

- a) In the "Reglement" section, please click the "Online-Nennformular" link.
- b) Enter the team name and the e-mail address. Select a password. Please be aware that the password is case-sensitive.
- c) Click on the "anmelden" button.

You now have access privileges and will receive a bilingual German/English e-mail with a link to the on-line entry form.

Attention: If you want to register more than one car, please repeat the full registration again and use **always a new password**.

Step 2 Entry:

- a) In the e-mail you received, click the link to the actual on-line entry form.
- b) Fill in all the fields (yellow fields are mandatory).
- c) Click on the "Send" button.

Your data will now be transmitted to ADAC, you will not be able to change your data anymore. Also, you will receive an e-mail containing a link to a printable version of your original entry form.

Step 3 Printable entry form:

- a) In the email you received, please click the link to the original entry form (pdf).
- b) Print the PDF form.
- c) Sign this form as a driver or have your legal guardian(s) sign it.
- d) If applicable, have it signed by your Competitor.
- e) Have the Team Principal sign the form.
- f) If applicable, have it signed by the vehicle's owner
- g) Post/fax the signed entry form to ADAC/Michael Rebhan. Fax + 49 89 7676 4430
- h) After you receive an invoice from ADAC, please remit the entry fee.

These three steps will conclude the on-line entry.

Please be absolutely sure to sign the printout of the entry form and to post the signed original to ADAC / Michael Rebhan *immediately*. The printout must also be signed by your Team Principal, and where applicable by your Competitor and the owner of the car.

This is necessary to make your entry legally binding.
